Tuesday 24 <sup>th</sup> September 9:30am-11:00am	Compass Challenge

Venus Baths Trail Head – Botanical Gardens	While exploring the Venus Baths trail, Junior Rangers will become Citizen Scientists by investigating the surrounding environment with help from a Ranger and members of the Friends of Grampians Gariwerd group to help us understand Climate Change.  BioBlitz encourages us to survey plants and animals in an area and determine changes!
