<b>Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September</b> <b>9:30am-11:00am</b>	<b>Compass Challenge</b>
Brambuk National Park and Cultural Centre	<i>Join a Ranger to learn basic navigation skills including map and compass reading techniques. Then put these skills into practise with a fun compass challenge!</i>
<b>Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September</b> <b>9:30am-11:00am</b>	<b>All Fired Up</b>
Brambuk National Park and Cultural Centre	<i>Join Rangers and Parks Victoria Fire Fighters to learn about fire safety and how to prepare during bushfire season in and around the National Park. Participants will also become Junior Ranger Fire Fighter accredited!</i>
<b>Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> September</b> <b>9:30am-11:00am</b>	<b>Bicycle Scavenger Hunt</b>
Halls Gap Park – Opposite the Visitor Information Centre	<i>Head off with a Ranger along the Halls Gap bike path to uncover different clues about Grampians National Park. Bring your own bike or visit Absolute Outdoors – main street of Halls Gap to hire a bike for the adventure.</i>

Brambuk National Park and Cultural Centre	<i>Join our Rangers to discover a bug's world and learn about the special wetland habitats of the Grampians National Park. Working as citizen scientists, Junior Rangers will determine the health of the wetland using exciting new skills!</i>
<b>Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October</b> <b>9:30am-11:00am</b>	<b>BioBlitz</b>
Venus Baths Trail Head – Botanical Gardens	<i>While exploring the Venus Baths trail, Junior Rangers will become Citizen Scientists by investigating the surrounding environment with help from a Ranger and members of the Friends of Grampians Gariwerd group to help us understand Climate Change. BioBlitz encourages us to survey plants and animals in an area and determine changes!</i>
<b>Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October</b> <b>9:30am-11:00am</b>	<b>Bush Detective</b>
Brambuk National Park and Cultural Centre	<i>Become a bush detective as you discover the fascinating features of Grampians National Park. Park Rangers will teach you about the different tracks and traces animals leave behind!</i>
